

Summary Statements

Rainfall for November 2020: November 2020 rainfall for Koror was normal.

Accumulated rainfall for September to November 2020, including outlook verification: The seasonal rainfall total for Koror for September to November 2020 was above normal. The verification outlook issued in August of 2020 was near-consistent.

Outlooks for January to March 2021:

1. SCOPIC: The SCOPIC outlook for January to March 2021 favours above normal.

2. ACCESS-S:

Monthly rainfall: The ACCESS-S outlook for January 2021 favours above normal rainfall across most of Palau, including Koror where the chances of above normal are about 60 to 70% for the main islands, and 60 to 80% for the southwest islands.

Monthly maximum and minimum temperatures: The ACCESS-S monthly maximum and minimum temperatures for January 2021 favours above normal maximum and minimum temperatures across Palau, including Koror where the chance of above normal is 90%.

Seasonal rainfall: The ACCESS-S seasonal rainfall outlook for January to March 2021 favours above normal rainfall for majority of the country, including Koror where the chance of above normal is about 60 to 70%. Over the far south of the country, the outlook indicates near-normal rainfall as the most likely outcome.

Seasonal maximum and minimum temperatures: The ACCESS-S seasonal maximum and minimum temperatures for January to March 2021 favours above normal maximum and minimum temperatures across Palau, including Koror where the chance of above normal is 90%.
