

Summary Statements

Rainfall for April 2020:

Hanan Airport's monthly rainfall (507 mm) was well above normal, being its second wettest April in 115 years of record. The highest is 584 mm in 1916.

Accumulated rainfall for February to April 2020, including outlook verification:

The accumulated rainfall for February to April 2020 was also above normal, with the outlook issued in January being verified as inconsistent.

Outlooks for June to August 2020:

1. SCOPIC:

The rainfall outlook for June to August offers little guidance as the chances of above normal, normal and below normal rainfall are similar.

2. ACCESS-S:

Monthly rainfall:

The outlook favours wetter than average for the month of June.

Monthly maximum and minimum temperatures:

The outlook favours a warmer than average June.

Seasonal rainfall:

The outlook favours wetter than average for the next three months.

Seasonal maximum and minimum temperatures:

The outlook favours warmer than average for June to August.
