

Hanan Airport's February rainfall was normal.

The accumulated rainfall for December to February was above normal, with the outlook issued in November being verified as consistent.

### **Outlooks for April to June 2021:**

#### 1. SCOPIC:

The outlook shows a near-equal likelihood of normal and above normal rainfall. Below normal is the least likely.

#### Monthly rainfall:

The outlook for April shows near normal rainfall as the most likely outcome.

#### Monthly maximum and minimum temperatures:

The outlook for April favours above normal temperatures.

#### Seasonal rainfall:

The outlook for April to June shows above normal rainfall as the most likely outcome.

#### Seasonal maximum and minimum temperatures:

The outlook for April to June favours above normal temperatures.
