Hanan Airport's July and May to July rainfall was below normal. Hanan airport recorded its 9th driest July on record and 10th driest May to July period.

Monthly/Seasonal rainfall and temperature Outlook statements

Niue's September and September to November rainfall is very likely to be below normal.

Maximum and minimum temperatures during September and averaged over September to November are very likely to be below normal.

Part 2: Recent Ocean summary statement

Monthly and last three months: July/May to July 2026

July and averaged over May to July Sea surface temperature (SSTs) around Niue were near normal -0.4 to 0.4°C.

July sea levels around Niue were 60 to 200mm above normal.

Coral Bleaching for Niue at no stress alert.

Part 2i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for September and September to November 2026

Ocean Variable statement

September sea surface temperatures around Niue are predicted to be 0.4 to 0.8°C below normal.

Averaged over September to November, sea surface temperatures around Niue are predicted to be 0.4 to 0.8°C below normal.

September and averaged over September to November, sea levels around Niue are predicted to be 30 to 100mm below normal.

Coral Bleaching outlook indicates no stress and warning for the next 16 weeks.

In brief for Teleconference

- Rainfall was below normal for July and May to July.
- The rainfall outlook generally indicates below normal rainfall for September 2026 and September to November 2026.
- SSTs for July and averaged over May to July were near normal. The outlook shows below normal SSTs for the next one and three months.
- Sea levels were abovenormal for September. Below normal sea levels are predicted for September and September to November.
