Monthly and last three months: August/June to August 2026 statement

Hanan Airport's August and June to August rainfall was below normal.

Part 1i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for October and October to December 2026

Monthly/Seasonal rainfall and temperature Outlook statements

Niue's October and October to December rainfall is very likely to be below normal.

Maximum and minimum temperatures during October and averaged over to December are very likely to be below normal.

Part 2: Recent Ocean summary statement

Monthly and last three months: August/June to August 2026

August Sea surface temperature (SSTs) around Niue were 0.4 to 0.8C below normal. Averaged over June to August Sea surface temperatures were near normal -0.4 to 0.4°C.

August sea levels around Niue were 60 to 100mm above normal.

Coral Bleaching for Niue at no stress alert.

Part 2i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for October and October to December 2026

Ocean Variable statement

October and averaged over October to December Sea surface temperatures around Niue are predicted to be 0.4 to 0.8°C below normal.

October and averaged over October to December, sea levels around Niue are predicted to be 30mm to 100mm below normal.

Coral Bleaching outlook indicates no stress and warning for the next 16 weeks.

In brief for Teleconference

- Rainfall was below normal for August and June to August.
- The rainfall outlook generally indicates below normal rainfall for October 2026 and October to December 2026.
- SSTs for August and averaged over June to August were below normal and near normal, respectively. The outlook shows near normal SSTs for the next one and three months.
- Sea levels for August were above normal. Sea levels are predicted to be below normal for October and October to December.
