## **Summary Statements**

#### Rainfall for March 2019:

All stations recorded *Below Normal* rainfall for the month of March. Apia and Nafanua recorded their lowest rainfall on record in March 2019 while Afiamalu and Faleolo recorded 6 and 7 driest March on record.

## Accumulated rainfall for January to March 2019, including outlook verification:

Apia and Nafanua stations recorded Below Normal rainfall while Afiamalu and Faleolo stations recorded Normal rainfall. All stations were verified to be consistent except for Faleolo which verified to be near consistent with the forecast.

## **Outlooks for May to July 2019:**

### 1. SCOPIC:

The Outlook shows Below Normal as the most likely, with Normal the next most likely for Apia and Afiamalu while Faleolo shows normal as the most likely with below the next likely. At Nafanua, the outlook offers little guidance as the chances of above normal, normal and below normal are similar.

#### 2. POAMA:

The outlook favours below normal as the most likely outcome for Apia station in the upcoming season.
