





# Part 2i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for August and August to October 2024



### **Summary Statement**

#### Monthly and last three months: June 2024/April to June 2024 statement

#### Monthly rainfall: June 2024

June rainfall was near-normal for most parts of the country, except for Lata where rainfall was above normal. Lata recorded its second wettest June on record.

### Three months rainfall: April to June 2024

Rainfall was above normal at Auki, Lata, Munda and Taro, and near-normal elsewhere. Auki recorded its wettest April to June period while Lata recorded its third highest.

### Part 1i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for August and August to October 2024

### Monthly /Seasonal rainfall and temperature Outlook statements

August and August to October rainfall is likely to be near-normal over most parts of the country.

### Part 2: Recent Ocean summary statement

#### Monthly and last three months: June 2024/April to June 2024

Ocean temperatures in June and averaged over April to June were 0.5 to 2.0°C above normal.

June sea levels around the Solomon Islands' main islands were utmost 150 mm above-normal.

Coral bleaching alert is on 'Watch' for most waters around the country.

### Part 2i. Monthly and Seasonal Outlooks for August and August to October 2024

#### **Ocean Variable statement**

August and averaged August to October Ocean temperatures around Solomon Islands are predicted to be 0.4 to 1.2 °C above normal.

August and the averaged August to October Sea levels are forecast to be near-normal around Solomon Islands, except for below normal sea levels (30 to 100mm) in the eastern most island group.

Coral bleaching outlook predicts 'No Stress' for most of the main islands.

#### **IN BRIEF for Teleconference**

- June rainfall was near-normal for most parts of the country, and near-normal to above normal for April to June.
- Near-normal rainfall is likely for August and over August to October 2024.
- SSTs were above normal for June and April to June 2024. The outlook predicts above-normal SSTs for the next one and three months.
- Sea-surface heights (SSHs) were near-normal in August and averaged over August to October 2024. SSHs are forecast to be below normal to near normal for the next one and three months.
