The Pacific Hydrology Services (PHS) Panel was established at the Fourth Meeting of the Pacific Meteorological Council (PMC-4) in Honiara 2017. It was established to serve in the capacity of an advisory committee to the PMC on hydrological services matters in the Pacific region, with emphasis on flood and drought warning and management at the national and regional level. The panel also works collaboratively with relevant partners on the development and implementation of new programmes and initiatives to enhance the capacities of PICTs to provide quality hydrological services.
