Central and Eastern North Pacific

NOAA 2021 Hurricane Season outlooks will be released on May 19 and May 20, respectively.

Western North Pacific

Tropical Cyclone activity in the Western North Pacific occurs year around. The NOAA 2021 Tropical Cyclone Season Outlook will be issued around June 1.


With a likely transition from La Niña to ENSO-Neutral in the next month or so, a near normal to below normal outlooks are anticipated.
